## 2017 IAAO Annual Conference Registration Now Open!

Registration for the 83rd Annual International Conference on Assessment Administration, September 24–27, 2017 at Bally's Las Vegas, is now open!

More than 1,500 attendees are expected at the 2017 conference and attendees can [register online](#) or download the [registration form](#).

The registration fee for the conference is \$595 for members and \$775 for nonmembers until July 21st and then increases to \$715 and \$895. Onsite registration pricing starts on September 9th with the fee for members at \$830 and \$1,015 for nonmembers.



### PROGRAMMING

The IAAO conference will get underway on Sunday, September 24 with the Opening Reception. Programs start on Monday, September 25 with the Opening Ceremony, featuring the keynote speaker, Steve Eisman, one of the most knowledgeable and respected analysts on Wall Street today. Mr. Eisman was one of the few who predicted the 2008 financial crisis and he was featured in Michael Lewis's 2010 book *The Big Short*. He was portrayed by Steve Carell in the 2015 movie adaptation of the book.



Featured conference plenary programs include *Valuation of Underperforming Regional Malls, Valuing the Las Vegas "Strip" -- Challenges & Limitations*, and *The Research and Findings of IAAO's Big Box Task Force*. IAAO also will offer approximately 60 educational sessions in the following areas: agricultural, commercial property, emerging issues, international issues, legal and legislative, management and personal development, residential, and technology trends and tools.
