

JEFF HUNT, CAE MEMORIAL CANDIDATES ASSISTANCE TRUST

The Jeff Hunt CAE Memorial Candidates Assistance Trust was created to provide grants to individuals, organizations, and projects for the purpose of furthering assessment education and professional designations of assessing officers. In 1989, Joseph E. Hunt, CAE established a memorial scholarship fund in remembrance of his son, Jeff, who died suddenly in an automobile accident. Jeff was a career assessment official who planned to submit his RES demonstration appraisal report as soon as he could save the money to have it typed. In response to these events, Mr. Hunt was moved to create this trust to assist candidates in IAAO's Professional Designation Program.

Grants will be awarded to IAAO member applicants who demonstrate financial need and who intend to use the funds for purposes that support the association's goals and objectives. The grants will be made on a first-come/first-served basis. **The grant is limited to one application by a candidate per calendar year.**

The application should be returned to the IAAO, Attention: Professional Designations, 314 W. 10th Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64105 or e-mailed to designations@iaao.org at least 60 days prior to the event to be attended. IAAO members applying for a Jeff Hunt Scholarship should read the following requirements and conditions:

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- Be a member in good standing of IAAO
- Demonstrate a need for a scholarship on both academic and financial grounds
- Demonstrate a desire to pursue an IAAO Professional Designation
- Submit the required application form

Scholarship Conditions

- Grants will be awarded to IAAO member applicants who demonstrate financial need and who intend to use the funds for purposes that support the association's goals and objectives.
- Grants will be made on a first-come/first-served basis at a frequency deemed appropriate by the committee.
- Applicants are limited to one application per calendar year.
- Successful applicants who subsequently decline the scholarship must reapply for future consideration.

Authority for disbursing grants is the sole responsibility of the Jeff Hunt CAE Memorial Candidates Assistance Trust Committee, which will make all final selections. Selections will be made based on the applications, amount of aid requested, and other factors as determined by the committee.
